<b>Under:</b>	Portuguese Swimming Federation
<b>Facilities:</b>	50 meters heated pool, 10 lanes; electronic timekeeping; 8 lanes 25m warm up/swim down pool
<b>Regulations:</b>	Under FPN and FINA regulations
<b>Ages:</b>	Males from 2008 and older; Females from 2009 and older
<b>Competition Mode:</b>	<b>Heats:</b> Heats will be run in two session and 10 lane formats: <u>A Sessions</u> will include Slow Heat for 400 IM, 800 Free female, 1500 Free male, and the fastest 30 entry times for all other events <u>B Sessions</u> will include all other entry times. There will be no heats for 400 IM, 800 and 1500 Free. <b>Finals:</b> There will two finals per event with the exception for the 400 IM, 800 and 1500 Free that will be swum by the 10 fastest entry times (Fast heat) Final B will precede Final A. <b>There will be no limit for foreign swimmers permitted to swim in each final.</b>

<b>Prizes:</b>	<b>Individual events:</b> medals and prizes between 50€ and 10€ <b>Relay events:</b> medals and prizes between 100€ and 25€ <b>Excellence subvention for teams:</b> Teams will receive 200€ for each swimmer above Fina Point Score defined on regulation

<b>Open training Session:</b>	There will be an open training session at the venue on Friday February 10 <sup>th</sup> between 2 & 8 pm. More information will be disclosed closer to competition date											
<b>Entry Limit:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All National and foreign federations teams or clubs are entitled to compete, providing that they are affiliated on FINA's members federations</li> <li><b>Ages:</b> males from 2008 and older; female swimmers from 2009 and older</li> <li>Swimmers may only enter on events for which they have qualified entry time</li> <li>Swimmers who have only qualified in one event may add one other event except for 400 IM, 800 and 1500 Free</li> <li>On 400 IM, 800 Free female &amp; 1500 Free male events only the best 20 entry times will be admitted. On 800 Free male &amp; 1500 Free female events only the best 10 entry times will be admitted. All other entries will be considered as reserves. Withdraws for these events should be communicated to the organizer 72 hours before the beginning of the competition, so that reserves can be notified. A fine of €30 will be issued to clubs who fail to comply</li> <li>Entry times should be achieved during the period between January 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 and January 30<sup>th</sup> 2023.</li> <li>Entry times should be achieved on Long Course or Short Course converted by FINA points.</li> <li>All swimmers must achieve competition standard times during the competition. Failure to do so will be subject to a fine of 12€.</li> </ul>											
<b>Competition format</b>	<p><b>Heats and Finals will be run in 10 lanes</b></p> <p><b>Heats:</b></p> <p>Heats will be run in two sessions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>A Session:</b> will include fastest 30 entry times for all events except for the 400 IM, 800 Free female and 1500 Free male that will include the slowest 10 entry times (slow heat).</li> <li><b>B Session:</b> will include all other entry times. There will be no heats for 400 IM, 800 or 1500 Free on this session.</li> </ul>											



## Admission times

If the number of entries is equal or below 10, there will be a direct A Final.

If a tie should happen in qualifying positions for finals, a swim-off will be held 10 minutes after the end of the session. If the tie involves swimmers from different sessions, the swim-off will be swum 10 minutes before the start of finals session

All absences from finals must be declared on official Withdraw Form and submitted to Organization no later than 30 minutes after event results are published.

### Finals:

There will be two finals per event with the exception for the 400 IM, 800 and 1500 Free that will have the fastest heat (10 fastest entry times)

If the number of finalists is below 20, there will be no B Final

Final B will precede Final A

All absences from finals that were not declared and submitted to Organization will be fined in 70€

### Relays:

Each club or team is only allowed to enrol one relay team per event

Relays team constitution must be submitted 60 minutes before the start of the session in which the race takes place

The names of the 4 relay team members swimming in the race and the order of swimming must be declared on the official relay form and submitted to Organization, no later than 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the race takes place. All competing swimmers must be entered in the meet Failure to do both will be subject to a fine of 50€ and disqualification of the relay team

subventions**

A 200€ subvention will be granted to teams for each swimmer that obtain a FINA point score equal or higher than:

Team subventions	
400, 800, and 1500 events	850 pts
50, 100, and 200 events	815 pts

Subvention will only be awarded once per swimmer

**Classifications**

Team classification will be made through points attributed based on events classification as followed:

Events points			
1 <sup>st</sup> Place	22 pts	5 <sup>th</sup> Place	16 pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	20 pts	6 <sup>th</sup> place	14 pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	18 pts	...	...
4 <sup>th</sup> Place	17 pts	20 <sup>th</sup> Place	1 pts

If a tie between two or more swimmers should occur, points attributed will be calculated by the sum of all points won divided by the number of swimmers in question

**Ties**

All ties for collective classifications will be resolved by using the number of best places obtained by the involved teams

## Event Prizes

Best three places of each **Final A** will be awarded with medals and the following prize moneys

It is a condition of attending arena Lisbon International Meeting that swimmers may be required to be tested for prohibited substances in accordance with the Portuguese Swimming Federation and /WADA/FINA Anti-Doping rules
